## **Minister, the Lord's Church, Arequipa, Peru – May 2014 to current**

I live and work in Arequipa, Peru, introducing people to Jesus of Nazareth through Bible study and theological reflection so that families and small communities can experience shared faith, hope, and love. I help elementary schools improve reading literacy with the Christian Urban Development Association, serving as treasurer on its board of directors. The Central Church of Christ in Little Rock, AR and the church of Christ at Cedar Lane in Tullahoma, TN oversee my work.

## **Director, Harding University Latin America, Arequipa, Peru – December 2018 to current**

I direct Harding University's study abroad program based in Arequipa, Peru. I organize the group's travel throughout Peru, Chile, and Argentina where we learn about history, culture, language, religion, economy, art, literature, music, and gastronomy. I teach the Latin American Humanities course through a historical-theological lens, among other courses.

## **Adjunct Faculty, Harding University in Florence, Scandicci, Italy – January 2014 to April 2014**

Lived in the HUF villa with 40 students in order to model holistic, cross-cultural learning. Worked with HUF director and staff to help students experience faith, relationships, study and Italian culture, food, history through a theological lens. Taught the following university courses: Missionary Anthropology, Life of Paul, and Speech Communication.

## **Field Director, Harding University in Zambia, Kalomo, Zambia – August 2012 to December 2012**

Directed the 2012 Harding University in Zambia study abroad program. Taught the following university courses: Missionary Anthropology, Speech Communication, and Field Work in Missions. Managed the course scheduling, field work opportunities, and program activities for 27 students and 7 faculty in Zambia, Tanzania, and Uganda. Framed the experience for the group through an anthropological lens to maximize the cross-cultural learning experience.

## **International Programs Administrator, Harding University, Searcy, AR – May 2011 to January 2012**

Communicated the nature and structure of all Harding University International Programs to small and large audiences (from a shared cappuccino with one student to groups of up to 5,000 people), addressing academic, travel, financial, and safety issues. Managed the International Programs web presence. Created and managed the International Programs social web platforms. Taught 1- to 2-week class sessions abroad. Prepared and implemented itineraries for groups traveling abroad. Once I helped students sign up for overseas programs from a kayak in the lily pond.

## **Honors College Secretary, Harding University, Searcy, AR – August 2009 to May 2011**

Represented the Harding University Honors College, Honors Symposium, and International Programs to high school and university students in a number of contexts, ranging from informal conversations to keynote presentations. Promoted Honors Symposium, hired counselors, and filled in for teachers in a number of disciplines as needed.
